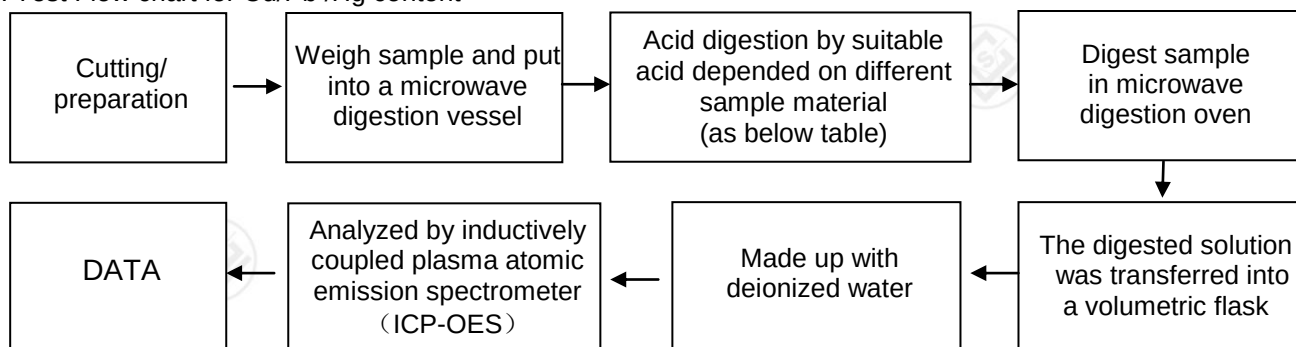

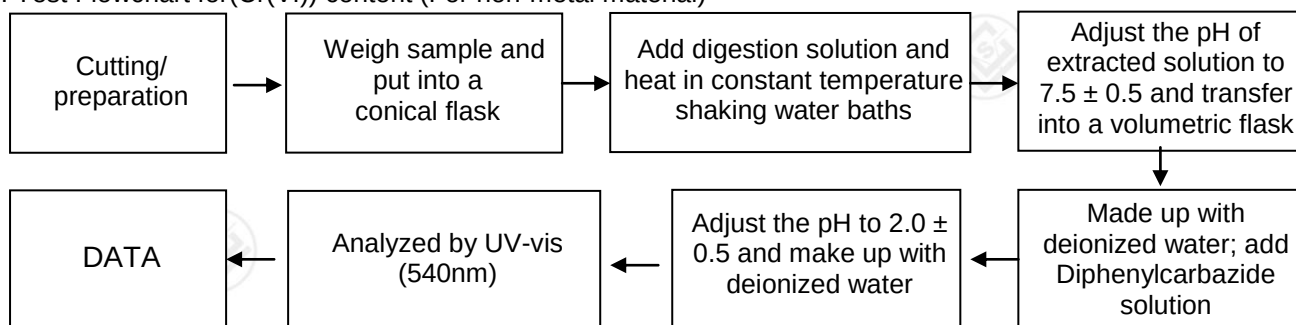

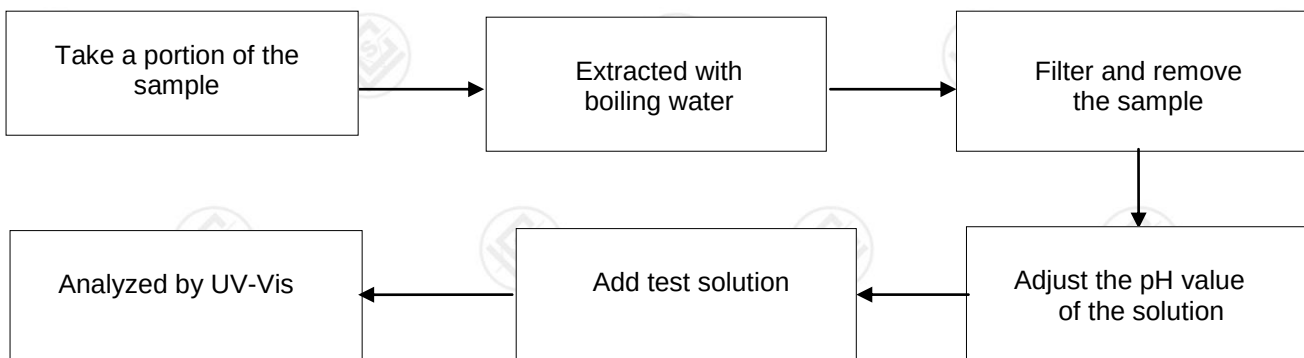
1. Test Flow chart for Cd/Pb /Hg content



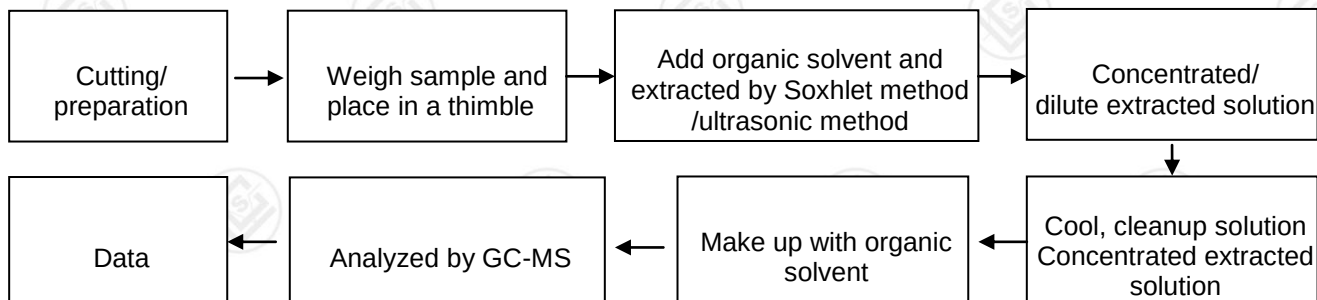
2. Test Flowchart for(Cr(VI)) content (For non-metal material)

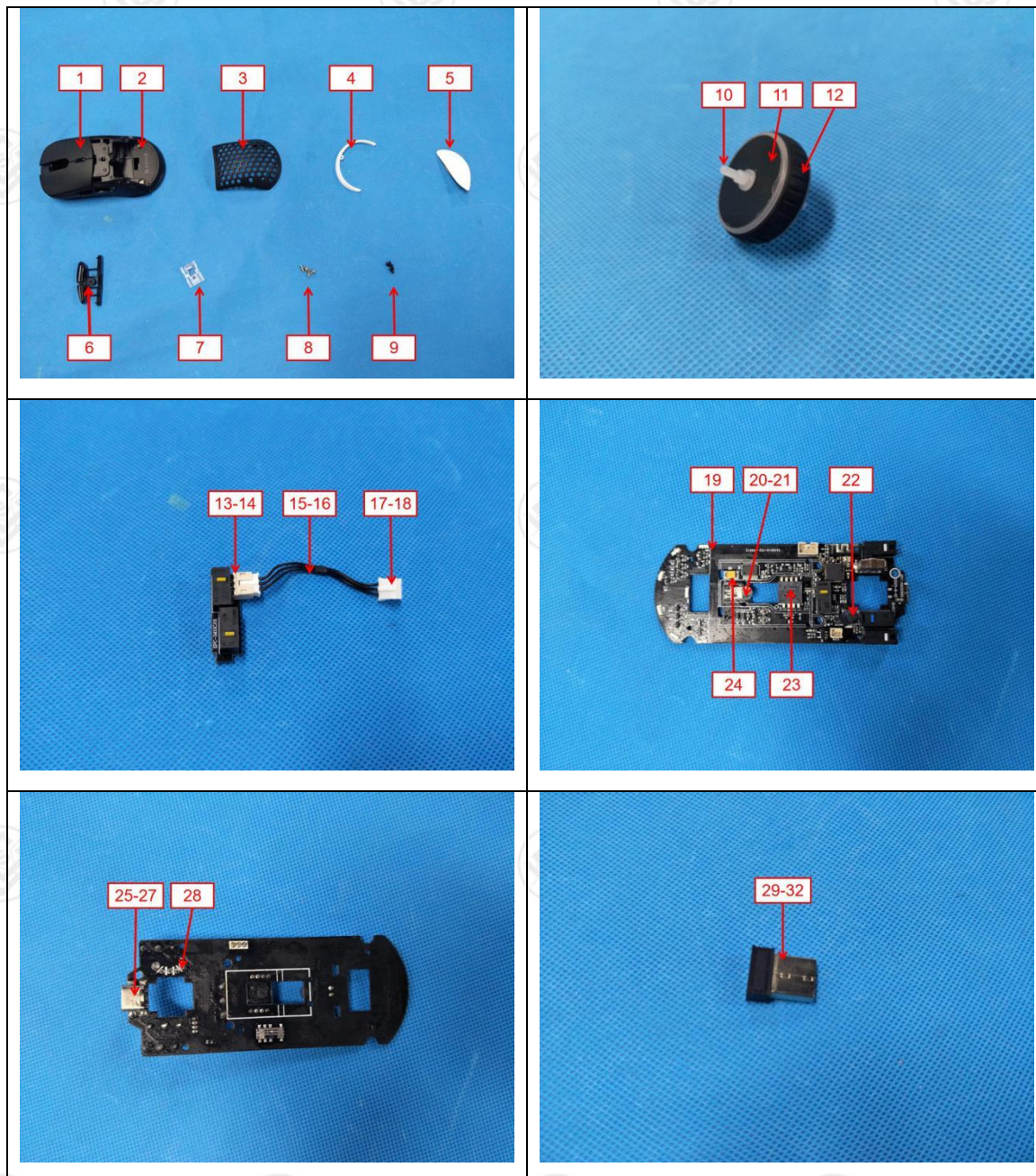

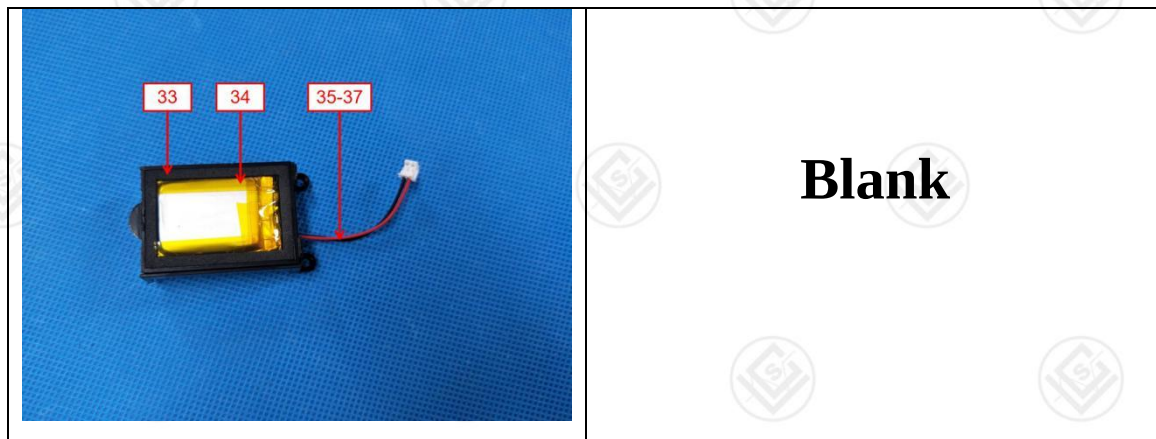
